

Top Ten Questions about the After Prom

Q1. What is the After Prom?

Every spring, a dedicated and fun-loving group of parents and friends of A.I. put on a party at AI *after* the Junior/Senior prom. It is an A.I. tradition that has become known as “the most eagerly anticipated event of the year.”

Q2. Why should you care?

Aside from being an evening to remember, filled with friends, laughs and enjoyment for the students, *it is a safe and effective solution to prevent drinking and driving.*

Q3. When is the After Prom?

Saturday, May 16, 2009, immediately following the Junior/Senior Prom.
Junior/Senior Prom at Chase Center on the Riverfront -- 7 PM to midnight
After Prom at AI duPont High School -- midnight until 3:00 AM, May 17, 2009

Q4. Who can attend the After Prom?

Any student or guest that attends A.I. Junior/Senior prom may attend the After Prom. The admission price is included with the Prom ticket (\$80 Students, Guests \$85). For A.I. Juniors or Seniors that do not wish to attend the prom, they may purchase a \$15 “After Prom Only” ticket.

Q5. What makes this event so special?

For starters, there is always a central theme that is kept completely top secret—only to be revealed when the students arrive at school. The theme is used to completely transform otherwise familiar places like the gym lobby into another world. It is an all-inclusive, “big-kid” playground with plenty of games, activities, food and music.

Q6. Who sponsors the After-Prom?

The PTSA sponsors the event with support from school administration, faculty and staff. However, this party takes many months of planning and effort to pull together. That job falls to the After Prom Committee, which is made up of parents and friends of A.I.

Q7. Why should you get involved, especially if your student is not a Junior or Senior?

One reason is to meet a great group of A.I. parents that share a common desire to continue another amazing A.I. tradition. Also, you will be demonstrating to your teenager the importance of volunteering your time and energy for the benefit of others.

Q8. What sort of “help” is needed?

“Many hands make light work.” With that in mind, the After Prom Committee needs all sorts of volunteers for the Decorating Committee and the Set-Up and Break-Down teams. Your level of involvement is up to you. If you can only spare a couple of hours of time here and there, no problem.
